We have kept millions of pounds of produce from landfills effectively lowering potent greenhouse gas emissions. With the approval of our Board of Directors we filed the necessary application with the State of Missouri to dissolve the organization and we are making every effort to maximize the remaining assets of the organization in support of hunger-fighting initiatives.
